



Call for Papers: Conference Proceedings for the IIUI-UNCW Academic and Research Partnership

To share scholarship that has resulted from the academic partnership between the University of North Carolina Wilmington and International Islamic University Islamabad, we will be publishing select papers from participants at the New Global City Conference (2016), and from participants at the Local Cities, Foreign Capitals Conference (2017). We seek to represent accurately the broad cross-section of disciplines featured at these conferences. We prefer work which explores the effects of globalization with an added focus on the local level, and local scholarship with an impact on globalization. All papers should be written with a cross-disciplinary audience in mind.

Submission Guidelines

All submissions must be previously unpublished. This call for papers is limited to only **those who have presented** at either of the two conferences. Submissions are limited to one per person, with a maximum 5,000-word count. Abstracts should be no longer than 300 words. Papers will undergo a double-blind review. Please submit the following documents: a title page which includes the title of the paper, institutional affiliation and contact details of the author and a short author bio, and the paper without the author's name in a separate document (a blind submission). Please use the APA style of referencing and citation.
