I. Professor Tim Unwin (UNESCO Chair in ICT4D)

Tim Unwin is an academic and practitioner who has devoted much of his life in seeking to serve the interests of the poorest and most marginalised. He is Emeritus Professor of Geography (since 2011) and Chairholder of the UNESCO Chair in ICT4D (since 2007) at Royal Holloway, University of London. He was Secretary General of the Commonwealth Telecommunications Organisation (CT0) from 2011-2015 and was Chair of the Commonwealth Scholarship Commission from 2009-2014. He is also an Honorary Professor at Lanzhou University in China. In 2018-19 he led the co-ordination of 21 UN agencies on behalf of UNESCO and UNICEF to develop a system-wide strategy on the future of education and learning for the UN's High Level Committee on Programmes and Chief Executives Board. He was appointed a Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St George (CMG) in the Queen's 90th Birthday Honours list in 2016 for his services to the Commonwealth.

Qureshi is an experienced campaigner with a strong demonstrated history of working in the Public relations, Communications, Branding, Marketing and high-profile events.
