It is stated that Hong Kong (SAR) has well reputed universities awarding Undergraduate, Post-Graduate and PhD degrees in various disciplines. It is pertinent to mention that medium of instruction in Hong Kong Universities is English. Consulate General of Pakistan, Hong Kong has approached various higher education institutions to obtain exclusive scholarships for Pakistani students. Brief about available scholarship opportunities is given below:

Undergraduate & Post-Graduate Scholarships:

Consulate General of Pakistan in Hong Kong is delighted to inform that it has successfully negotiated dedicated scholarships for Pakistani undergraduate students in The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) and Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU). CUHK's scholarship is for the whole study program (amounting to US\$ 98,000/-) which thoroughly covers the tuition fees and all the accommodation expenses. Moreover, the University will provide confirm accommodation in its on-campus hostels. While HKBU has offered two exclusive scholarships for Pakistani applicants (covering full tuition fee). Fully and partially funded scholarships under the Belt and Road initiative are also granted to successful applicants which are besides the above stated dedicated scholarships for Pakistani students.

The Chinese University of Hong Kong is currently 39th in the World (QS World University Rankings 2022), has 15 Rhodes Scholars and also boosts of producing 4 Nobel Laureates. The applications for admissions are open until 6th January 2022 (Applications may be accepted subject to availability of places after deadline). Hong Kong Baptist University enrolls around 11,000 students and offers over 40 undergraduate programs, over 40 taught postgraduate programs, and research programs leading to the award of MPhil and PhD under its six Faculties/Schools and the Academy of Visual Arts. PhD & MPhil Scholarships:

Established by the Research Grants Council (RGC) of Hong Kong in 2009, the Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (HKPFS) aims at attracting the best and brightest students in the world to pursue their PhD studies in Hong Kong's universities.

The Fellowship provides an annual stipend of HK\$322,800 (approximately US\$41,400) and a conference and research-related travel allowance of HK\$13,500 (approximately US\$1,730) per year for each awardee for a period up to three years. 300 PhD Fellowships will be awarded in the 2022/23 academic year. For awardees who need more than three years to complete the PhD degree, additional support may be provided by the chosen universities.
