INSTRUCTIONS FOR HIFZ TEST

Hifz Test is a degree requirement at IIUI. The students have to pass the Hifz Test after appearing in exam/viva after which they can obtain the Final Transcript/Degree which is impossible without passing Hifz test. The Syllabus of Hifz test vary from faculty to faculty at IIUI.

All BS/MS/PhD students are hereby directed to follow the instructions to appear for Hifz Test;

1. In Faculty of Basic and Applied Sciences, Department of Environmental Science, **Last 20 Surah's of The Holy Quran from Surah Alt-Teen to Surah Aln-Naas with English Translation - both learnt by heart (Memorization) are included in syllabus.**
2. The Syllabus is available at department website and Photocopier shop and can be downloaded from the link below;

3. **All students are directed not to appear for Hifz test exam/viva without complete preparation, i.e., memorization of last 20 Surah's with English Translation.**
4. **All students are informed to complete this degree requirement well in time and pass this test during the study period as you can appear for Hifz Test in 1st semester, 2nd semester till last semester of degree.**
5. **Don't wait for passing the final semester exam or final Thesis/project viva to appear for Hifz Test and appear for exam well in time without waiting for final viva of thesis/final semester to avoid further problems.**

6. No other way or short cut is there at DES, FBAS for passing Hifz Test. You have to appear for exam and pass it by hard working and proper preparation.
7. No students will be entertained on emergency basis during semester break for Hifz Test.
8. In working semesters, every Wednesday from 12.00pm, to 02:00pm is fixed for taking Hifz Test.
9. In this case please avoid personal contacts on mobile/Whatsapp Numbers of the Examiner/Evaluator. You can inform and register your complete information to program office before appearing for Hifz test.
10. Strong disciplinary action will be taken against those students who will try to approach through any reference obtaining recommendation or “Safarish”.
