Due to increased day by day demands from visually impaired community from all over the country, there is an urgent need to construct a new building for the organization. PFFB new building setup will enhance Organizational capacity to upscale outreach services i.e. awareness and rehabilitation services, educational services through audio recorded books, capacity building trainings in Assistive Information Technology, personality development and livelihood, assistive technology & technical support, and employment opportunities.
