Scotland Pakistan Scholarship Scheme for Young Women and Girls 2025 **For Bachelor's /BS Programs & Two Years Degree Program (Master's/M-Phil)**

The Scotland Pakistan Scholarships for Young Women and Girls funds graduate studies for Pakistani women in any HEC recognized university across Pakistan. Funded by the Scottish Government, these grants aim to make higher education more accessible to women, supporting them in achieving their potential and ambition.

The Award:

Scotland Pakistan Scholarships for Young Women and Girls Scheme will facilitate award-holders with the following:

- Tuition fees for courses in eligible fields
- University hostel costs (where applicable)
- Travel to and from home to university two times a year for students staying in on-campus hostels

Subject Areas:

The scholarship will cover a four-year bachelor's and two years' two-year master's/MPhil degree at an HEC-recognized Pakistani university in one of the following subject areas only:

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be pursuing a two-year master's /Mphil degree or four years' bachelor's degree in the above listed subject areas

- Hold a confirmed admission offer from an HEC recognized university in Pakistan
- Copy of offer letter or confirmation of admission from HEC recognized university/college. (You may also provide a fee challan, transcript, or student ID card if a confirmation letter is not available)
- Please note, you may submit the scholarship application without an offer letter, BUT scholarship offers will not be made unless an offer letter or proof of admission has been submitted to the British Council upon request.

Young women with disabilities, from rural areas and/or minority groups are encouraged to apply.


