PURCHASE OF BATTERIES FOR UNIVERSITY VEHICLES

International Islamic University, Islamabad invites E-BIDS on E-PADS on F.O.R basis from well reputed Companies/Firms/Dealers/Manufacturers or their Authorized Sale Distributors/ General Order Suppliers registered with Income Tax, Sales Tax Department and are on FBR's active taxpayers list (ATL) for Purchase of Batteries for different types of University Vehicles i.e. Bedford, Hino, Nissan Buses, Coasters, Toyota Hiace, Toyota Hilux/Vigo, Shehzore, various models of Cars, Suzuki Vans, Jeep, motor cycles etc. In addition to E-Bids submitted through E-PADS, bidders are also required to submit their bids in hard form at the time of Bids opening. Submission of E-Bids is mandatory and only those hard copy bids will be considered that fully comply with the E-Bidding requirements.

2. Bidding documents containing detailed terms and conditions etc. may be downloaded from IIUI website [www.iiu.edu.pk/](http://www.iiu.edu.pk/) , PPRA website [www.ppra.org.pk](http://www.ppra.org.pk). OR EPADS [www.eprocure.gov.pk/](http://www.eprocure.gov.pk/). The Price of the bidding documents is Rs.3000/- (Non-refundable) in shape of Call Deposit/Bank Draft in favor of IIUI.

3. The bids, prepared in accordance with instructions in the bidding documents, along with Bid Security/Earnest money of 2% of the total bid value in the shape of Bank Draft/Pay Order drawn in favor of International Islamic University, Islamabad may reach Office of the undersigned on or before **December 01, 2025 at 11:00AM**. The bids will be opened on the same day at **11:30 AM** in presence of the Bidders or their representatives.

4. As per PPRA Rules 33(1), 2004, International Islamic University, Islamabad (IIUI), has the right to reject any or all E- Bids/proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of E- Bid/proposal.

Subject: **TENDER DOCUMENT FOR PURCHASE OF BATTERIES FOR UNIVERSITY VEHICLES**

**Terms & Conditions**

1. Any addition, deletion, or modification of the procurement terms & conditions of International Islamic University, Islamabad (IIUI) by any vendor shall not be acceptable and may lead to rejection of the bid.
2. Original Manufacturers / Authorized Distributors / General Order Suppliers (with valid Authorization/Distribution Certificate), registered with Income Tax and Sales Tax Departments and appearing on the Active Taxpayers List (ATL) of FBR, are eligible to participate in this tender.
3. Authorized dealers shall attach a valid copy of their dealership authorization certificate.
4. The participating companies/firms/dealers etc. shall submit an affidavit affirming that they have not been blacklisted by any government, semi-government, or autonomous organization.
5. Bidding documents shall be accompanied by a Call Deposit Receipt (CDR)/Pay Order/Bank Draft of Rs. 3000/- as Tender Fee (Non-Refundable) and a Call Deposit Receipt (CDR)/Pay Order/Bank Draft Bid Security/Earnest Money 2% of the total bid value (Refundable) in favor of International Islamic University, Islamabad. In case of successful bidder, the Earnest Money will be held for **Performance Guarantee Period**.
6. Quality/Quantity/make/ type of Batteries must be ensured by the firm/supplier. In case of supply of Sub-Standard Batteries, the firm/Supplier shall be bound to bear the loss occurred to the purchaser.
7. The exact completion/delivery time from the date of issuance of Purchase/Work Order shall not exceed 20 days. Timely delivery is of critical importance.
8. The Purchase Order will be awarded to the most advantageous Bidder, i.e., lowest evaluated/technically compliant Bidder, on the basis of item-wise or grand total-wise evaluation, as per nature of BoQs and compatibility requirements.
9. IIUI will adopt the Single Stage, Single Envelope procedure in accordance with PPRA Rules, 2004.

10. The prices shall be quoted in local currency i.e., Pakistani Rupees (PKR), inclusive of all applicable taxes, on F.O.R. basis.
11. Prices shall remain valid for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of bid opening. Withdrawal or modification of the bid within this period will result in forfeiture of Earnest Money and may also lead to blacklisting of the vendor.
12. The decision of the Purchase/Evaluation Committee regarding the evaluation of bids and award of contract shall be final and binding, and shall not be subject to further correspondence or claims.
13. In case of failure to deliver goods within the stipulated period, the following penalties shall apply:
  - a) Late Delivery Charges (LD) shall be levied @ 2% per month of the total Purchase Order value, up to a maximum of 10%. Deductions will be made from the supplier's invoice.
  - b) In case of failure to deliver the goods/services within the stipulated or extended time period, the Purchase Order shall stand cancelled, Earnest Money will be forfeited, and the supplier may also be blacklisted.
14. The manufacturing date of batteries shall not be more than 06 months. Supplies failing to meet specifications shall be rejected upon inspection. The bidder/vendor will be bound to replace such items at no additional cost to IIUI, failing which the Purchase Order will be cancelled and Earnest Money confiscated.
15. Bidders shall submit the technical/data sheet of the offered batteries, clearly indicating the materials and ingredients used in their manufacture.
16. It shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder/agent/supplier/manufacture to comply with applicable national and international laws.
17. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Grievance Redressal Committee, IIUI, shall be final and binding upon both parties.
18. IIUI reserves the right to modify the quantities (increase/decrease) before award of the Purchase Order.
19. Payment(s) will be made as per rules, after successful delivery and submission of the invoice.
20. The bidder/company must specify the warranty of batteries, both in terms of performance and time period.

21. IIUI reserves the right to reject any bid under the following conditions:
  - (i) Ambiguous or conditional
  - (ii) Submitted by a blacklisted firm.
22. As per Rule 33 of PPRA Rules, 2004, IIUI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason.
