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Ahmad Gunny's latest work has admirably extended the frontiers of several disciplines — of literary Orientalism, of Inter-Faith and Cross-cultural studies, of history and of the Western intellectual history. His earlier studies, *Images of Islam in Eighteenth Century Writings* (1996)¹ and *Perception of Islam in European Writings* (2004)² have been acclaimed as perceptive analysis of the chequered
