# STEP 1:

The following steps will Enable POP in your IIUI Email Account

To check your email in Outlook Express, please first follow these steps below.

- 1. Log in to your IIUI email account.
- 2. Click **Settings** at the top of IIU email page.
- 3. Click Forwarding and POP/IMAP.
