

REPORT OF IIU IDPs FUND COLLECTION AND PAYMENT

Looking into the difficulties of IDPs of North Waziristan who migrated from their homeland due to military operation “Zarb-e-Azab” by Pak Army, the International Islamic University, Islamabad (*with the approval of the President*) started collecting funds to help the displaced peoples. For this purpose the University launched the campaign of fund raising in the Faisal Masjid on 4th July 2014 (Friday) and 11th July 2014 (Friday) by setting six camps, which consisted of 05 camps of male and one female. In the meanwhile, the University started to see the right person who could approach the most affected IDPs in the area of Bannu and Karrk.





One of the Professors of the University, Mr. Islam ud Din, Assistant Professor Environmental Science who belongs to Waziristan was contacted who promised that he will not only locate the most deserving IDPs who are head of a family and collect them at a designated place for provision of relief by the University. Dr. Islam assigned the task to his brother residing at Bannu who started working on the mission as University team planned to visit Bannu on 12th July (Saturday). The University also located a person of Karrk Mr. Ruban Younas, Assistant Director (HR) of the University and assigned him the duty to locate the most deserving family heads of IDPs residing in Karrk for provision of relief by the University. He designated this job to his brother residing in Karrk and started collecting the data. With these arrangements the University started the mission of distribution of relief to the affectees.

As such an amount of [Rs.452087/-](#) and [Rs.332,400/-](#) was collected in two days respectively.

On 11th July 2-014 (Saturday), the University provided a Toyota Hiace to the team of the following for visiting to Bannu and Karrk for distribution of Rs.10,000/- to each affected family:

The team started its journey at 6:30 morning for Karrk and reached at 11:30 a.m. After taking some rest at Karrak, the team moved to the District Bannu where Dr. Islam ud Din welcomed the team at the main road and lead the team to the designated place where all the affectees were gathered. The team after recording their CNIC, names, father's name and thumb impression, paid Rs.10,000/- to each affected family head. Total number of 46 family heads were covered. Since the team was having fast, so despite the insistence of Dr. Islam ud Din to stay till Aftari, the team started their journey for Karrk. The team reached Karrk at 3:00 p.m where Mr. Rubhan Younis welcomed the team and lead the team to Karrak Town Hall, where selected most deserving head of families of IDPs were gathered. The team distributed Rs.10,000/- each after completing the [record of every individual](#). The total number of 26 IDPs families were paid the relief. As such total amount of Rs. 460,000/- for Bannu as well as Karrk has been paid out of the collection of Rs. 260,000/- collected through the camps set at Faisal Masjid on 4th and 11th July 2014 (Fridays).
