- File size not exceeding 2 MB

- A4 size paper
- Margins must be 1 inch on all sides
- Font size 10 Times New Roman (body text)

- Single spacing
- Proposals should not exceed 2 pages

Actual Poster Presentation

- One A1 size per poster presentation

WORKSHOP

- Should not be programmes previously conducted by presenter(s)
- Not research presentations
- Aimed at developing knowledge, skills, or new perspectives for participants
- Proposals should not exceed 1500 words (about 3 pages)
- A4 size paper
- Margins must be 1 inch on all sides
- Font size 10 Times New Roman (body text)
- Single spacing

Include the following information for workshops:

- Facilities required
- Maximum number of participants
- Intended audience and degree of expertise or background knowledge required by participants
- Statement of workshop objectives
- Detailed description of workshop contents, including activities for participants
- A list of previous presentations on the same topic or publication references or (optionally) nominate one or two referees whom the conference committee may contact
- A summary of the workshop presenter's qualifications

Keywords: One line only of key or focus terms used in your paper

First level heading in Arial 12 bold

Use Times New Roman 10 point, left aligned, single spaced for the body of your paper. There should be only one blank line before and after headings, sized to Times New Roman 10 point.

Paragraphs should be separated with a single blank line with no indents. Do not use *Spacing Before* or *Spacing After* (in the Format Paragraph dialogue box) for your paragraphs.

Second level heading in Arial 10 bold

Put a blank line before and after the second level heading, formatted as before.
