TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- i. The bidder should be registered with income tax and sales tax departments and on the Active Tax Payer List issued by FBR.
- ii. Bidders should submit valid Ticketing License issued by the Govt. of Pakistan.
- iii. Do not quote "Scheme Rates". The quotation must be for full fare economy class. Scheme rates will not be evaluated.
- iv. Rates to be quoted on credit bases; however payment mode will be negotiated with selected bidder.
- v. Name of airline with confirmed seats and itinerary be mentioned in the quotation.
- vi. Airline quoted by the bidders will be evaluated in terms of reputation and facilities provided to the passenger. Selection will not be made merely on the basis of lowest rates.
- vii. One complimentary ticket will have to be provided.
- viii. The details of the traveler(s) will be provided in the work order.
- ix. Group of Passenger cannot be divided in to further small or sub-groups.
- x. Unconditional hike in fare or change in airlines at the time of travel will not be accepted.
- xi. Quoted rates shall be unconditional and valid for a period of 45 days from the date of opening the quotation.
- xii. No complaint either in written or verbal shall be accepted from the travel agent after the award is finalized.
- xiii. Any bid received by the purchaser after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the purchaser, will be declared "Late" and rejected.
