### **Training Methodology**

The experience shows that the conventional training in quantitative methods makes the students memorize the theorems and formulae, but does not enable them to handle a real data set. Therefore full attention is given to enable the participants to apply the techniques being learned to real data. Every lecture session is followed by a practical session in which participants will be required to apply the techniques learned in the session to real data. The resource persons along with a group of teaching assistants will help the participants handling the real data. The practical sessions will be conducted in a fully equipped computer lab with necessary software and DSL facility.
